who we are

COTS, Inc. is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization helping individuals experiencing homelessness in the Fox Cities. We provide transitional shelter to individuals in Outagamie, Winnebago and Calumet counties. Our goal is to end homelessness by enabling individuals to transition to self-sufficiency and independent living.

We are home to over 60 individuals on a daily basis. Case management, living skill classes and basic needs (shelter, utilities, food and household and personal needs) are provided to each resident in our program for up to two years. We also provide two years of Aftercare Services following successful transition.



what we do

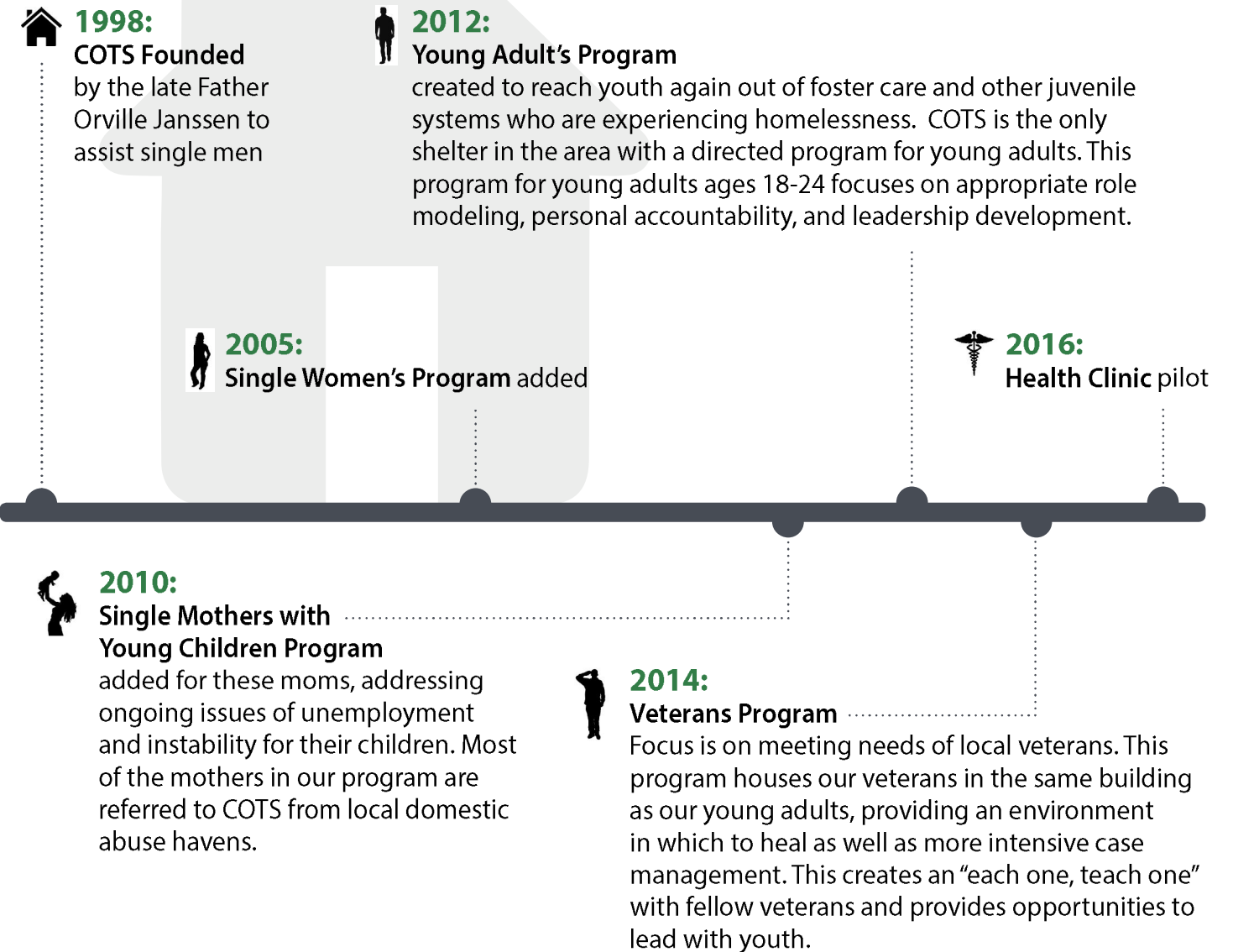
COTS has five specific adult programs focused on addressing the root causes of homelessness:
