Program Rules for Residents

- Remain free from drugs & alcohol
- Abide by curfew which is 11 pm on weekdays and 12 pm on weekends
- Complete daily building maintenance
- Attend required meetings and classes
- Adhere to visiting hours
- Work your program
- Maintain 40 hours of meaningful activity each week

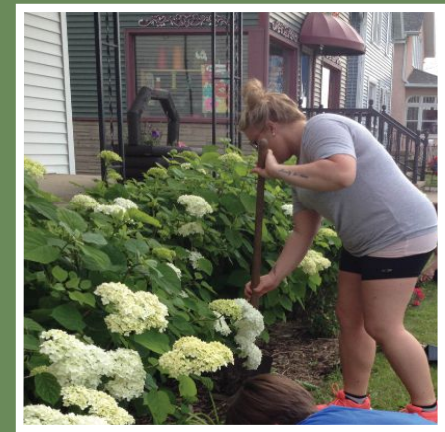
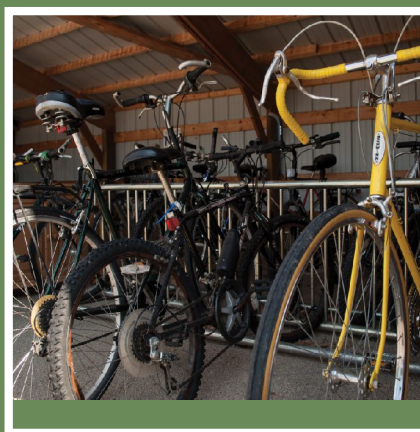

- Staff contacts you for an interview. In addition, we gather personal information and conduct reference and criminal background checks.
- Intakes are done on a continuous basis and accepted applicants are placed on a wait list
